Hello Bill,

I hope you are doing well. I wanted to reach out to you to put you in touch with Mike Harris and Geoff Giffin, project managers for Kimley Horn who are managing the Route 15 road improvement project.

The project is currently in the study phase but will ultimately produce options for traffic mitigation on Route 15. My overall goal is to identify a solution that will address the congestion concerns while preserving the rural nature of Route 15. Because Route 15 is a major section through the Journey's National Heritage Area, I would like to include you in our future outreach efforts once the study is complete but Supervisor Umstadd and I would like you to be involved in the effort now so that the Journey may have the opportunity to share general design ideas and solutions with the project managers early in the process.

By way of this email, I will request that Mike and Geoff reach out to you to arrange a meeting on this issue along with County staff and staff from our offices. Bill, thanks for all the great work you do. Please let me know if you have any questions or if you would like to discuss further.
